### 2. 4C and ARCCA Updates - Heather Allen (5 mins)

4C finalized our Strategic Vision, updated our by-laws, restructured our steering committee to be more representative of our membership. We assisted members in submitting three Strategic Growth Regional Climate Collaborative grant applications as well as a Community Economic Resilience Fund application. Hosted a Justice, Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion training, supported a 5-part Carbon Sequestration Webinar series and promoted the Resilient Central Coast campaign.
